Somerset County will be performing road construction on Belle Mead-Blawenburg Road (CR 601) in Montgomery Township. The road will be permanently closed the entire week from Monday, April 14, 2014 through Tuesday, April 22, 2014 at the CSX Railroad crossing (south of Grandview Road) in order to improve the railroad crossing.

Traffic will be detoured via Sunset Road, US Route 206, and Dutchtown Harlingen Road during this time.
