Summary statements only of debt service are required. The use of summarized forms is permitted to conserve time. Responsibility for the supporting detail is placed on the chief financial officer who must be in a position to support the summarized figures.

No sheets should be eliminated, except utility fund sheets under the conditions stipulated on Sheet 2. Those sheets not filled in should be marked "Not Applicable".
