EMS Week Kicks off with Sunday Open House

Pancakes, CPR Classes, KidPrints, Car Seat Checks and More!

This Sunday, May 18 Montgomery EMS will hold it's annual Open House at the squad building located at 8 Harlingen Road in Belle Mead. Among the many Open house activities planned, you can join us for free Family and Friends CPR classes, a Pancake Breakfast fundraiser and a Pet CPR and First Aid class.



Come visit MEMS' Open House Sunday!

The Family and Friends CPR class is an American Heart Association non-certification class. The class length is 45 minutes and teaches you how to perform CPR on Adults or infants and how to help an adult or infant who is choking. There are 2 Adult sessions (9:30am and Noon) and one infant session (11am) scheduled (infant is defined as a child one year old or younger). Reservations are required for each session (register at mems47.org) and there is a maximum of 30 attendees per session.

The Pancake breakfast fundraiser will be held between 9 am and noon. Enjoy HOT & FRESH made-to-order all-you-can-eat pancakes along with a variety of snacks and beverages while enjoying some live entertainment too! The cost is Adults \$8, Seniors \$6 and Children \$4.

The Pet CPR and First Aid class is scheduled at 1 PM and is a 2 hour class. The cost is \$10/person and the class is limited to the first 12 people who register by sending an email to info@mems47.org.

Montgomery PD will also be on hand to issue Fingerprint ID cards and members of Squad 47 and Montgomery Fire Station #1 will offer Ambulance & Firetruck Tours.

On Thursday, May 22 from 1-4, Montgomery EMS will hold its second event, free car seat checks together with the Princeton Healthcare System. This event will also be held at the Montgomery EMS building. If you wish to have your car seat checked you must make an appointment ahead of time by calling 1.888.897.8979, walk-ins will only be permitted if time permits.

Mary Jacob Library Closing May 27th to June 5th

Freeze Your Holds or Change Pick-up Location

Beginning Tuesday May 27, the Mary Jacobs Library, a branch of the Somerset County Library System located at 64 Washington Street in Rocky Hill, will be closed for ten days. The Library plans on reopening on Thursday June 5.

During this time, a new HVAC unit will be installed, and, due to the location of the old and new units, the Lobby and Circulation Desk will be the main work area. To ensure the safety of library visitors and staff, the entire building needs to be closed. Staff are advising patrons to change the pick-up location for their holds to a nearby branch or to "freeze" them until June 5.

All Library programs previously scheduled for this time have been canceled or rescheduled. Please call Mary Jacobs Library, 609-924-7073 or consult the on-line events calendar for additional information.
